




Goals

First GPF Congress

By 30 November 2024 ... the Board of Directors convenes the first Congress of the Global Pickleball Federation.

- At this general assembly of GPF members and allied continental federation representatives,
 the Board presents updates on the Core Four and the ACTIVE 8.
- Revisions to key performance indicators and other amendments to the Bylaws are reviewed.
- An open forum and networking session are provided.

- Progress on the **ACTIVE 8** is presented and discussed.
- The Board of Directors' report on the phased progression and next steps for the GPF is presented and discussed.
