### Pickleball for the people!





#### Program Vision:



PICKLEBALL FOR THE PEOPLE aims to make pickleball a universally accessible sport, fostering inclusivity and camaraderie across Africa. It emphasizes that pickleball should not be limited to exclusive clubs or specialized groups but should be available to everyone, regardless of age, location, or background.

This program will send **PICKLEBALL AMBASSADORS** from active pickleball countries to non-pickleball playing countries/regions with a mission kit to introduce the game.



**Awareness Campaigns:** 

Launch comprehensive marketing and awareness campaigns to highlight the benefits of pickleball, including its accessibility, health benefits, and the social connections it fosters.



Establish partnerships with local governments, educational institutions, and sports organizations to facilitate the introduction and integration of pickleball into existing sports and physical education programs.

















#### **Exchange Programs:**

 Create exchange programs that allow African players and coaches to train with established pickleball communities globally, fostering knowledge exchange and international camaraderie.





## Equipment and Resource Distribution:

- Equipment Kits: Prepare kits including paddles, balls, portable nets, and instructional materials.
- Partnership with Suppliers:
   Negotiate deals with
   equipment manufacturers for
   discounts or donations.





#### Training and Development:

- Implement comprehensive training programs for players of all skill levels, from beginners to advanced competitors, ensuring a pathway for development and excellence.
- Recruitment of Trainers: Hire experienced pickleball players and coaches.
- Conduct regular coaching workshops led by experienced pickleball players and trainers to certify local coaches, equipping them with the knowledge and skills to teach and spread the game.
- Training Programs: Conduct workshops and training sessions for local coaches and players.
- Certification: Provide certification for local coaches to ensure quality and sustainability.





# Community Engagement and Awareness:

- Local Partnerships: Collaborate with local sports clubs, schools, and community centres.
- Establish community-based programs that support ongoing play, competition, and social events, creating a vibrant and self-sustaining pickleball culture.
- Engage with local communities through workshops, demonstrations, and pickleball events to spark interest and encourage participation across all age groups and demographics.
- Cultural Sensitivity Training: Ensure all participants understand and respect local cultures and customs.
- Promotional Activities: Use social media and local media to promote events and activities.





- Feedback Mechanisms: Establish systems for feedback from local communities and participants.
- Impact Assessment: Regularly assess the impact of the program on pickleball growth and community development.
- Adaptation and Improvement: Continuously refine the program based on feedback and assessments.








### Long-Term Sustainability:
